## Friday Tennis Club

We are delighted to announce the continuation of the After School Tennis Club. This club has historically been very popular and is run by a professional coach. We are offering this club out to pupils in year 2, 3 and 4 for the Spring 2 Term – 2023. To make this club viable we will need a minimum of 14 pupils with a maximum capacity of 20 pupils. Places are allocated on a first come basis.

The club will held on six consecutive Friday's and will run from 24<sup>th</sup> February to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023. Tennis Club will be run between the hours of 3.30pm till 4.30pm and at a total cost of £39.00.

Children will need to bring appropriate sports clothing and trainers if they are not already wearing them in school that day – they will change in to these before their session.

Children will need to be collected by a parent/carer from the school main entrance promptly at the end of their session. If your child usually attends Care Club on a Friday and you collect after 4.30pm, they will be escorted to Care Club until you are able to pick them up.

If you would like to reserve a space then please log into your Scopay account and select the event titled 'Tennis Spring 2'. We will require you to provide consent, ensure you advise us of any medical conditions or information that you feel we should pass on to the coach and make full payment. Please note to guarantee your place payment needs to be made at the point of booking. There are a limited number of spaces available which will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If all spaces have been allocated the event will automatically close on-line and be unavailable to book.

As with all trips, a child's attendance will be at the discretion of the head teacher. A child may not be able to attend if, following a risk assessment, it is assessed they would be at risk themselves or put others at risk.
